They try to attend as many events as possible.</li> <li>• She thanked parents for all we do and for keeping all students involved.</li> <li>• Counselors and Admin are working on the Master Schedule.</li> <li>• Next year they'll be offering a 5<sup>th</sup> hour to try to off-load the morning senior classes which are now crammed with 40 kids. The 5<sup>th</sup> hour will have the same amount of minutes as current periods. Students can also come to school at 8:30 and stay for 4 classes or take an extra class. Some classes offered will be the Engineering capstone classes, drama 7-8, Spanish 9-10, government/econ, and English. 27 teachers offered to teach 5<sup>th</sup> period.</li> <li>• Teachers are working on the teacher/student relationships.
