Grants	Kris Hardison	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • She explained the grant process. • We have requirements to be eligible for grants – such as both the treasurer and president of the club have to attend the green and gold meeting. (This may be a phone conference.) Another requirement is for the PAWS rep to attend at least 5 of 7 meetings even if they are out of season. • Paperwork is online.
UPC	George Gonzalez	<p>UPC stands for United Parent Council –</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • UPC advocates for students, parents and teachers at the district level. It is a group of parent representatives for each of the district schools that participates in monthly meetings at the district level. We engage in discussion, presentations and participate in district committees to assist in the decision making process on programs, policies, processes ...etc for our schools. PVUSD serves as a model for other districts in the state as many do not have one. UPC has been a great partner with PVUSD for over 25 years... • First meeting was held on August 15. • Dr Jim Lee, PVUSD Superintendent shared several items with us: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ New school year started with renewed energy from everyone at the district and specially our teachers ○ Teachers came in 5 days before start of school (last year was 3 days – due to budget). The 2 new days were due to Results Based Funding ○ PVUSD had the following salary increases: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Certified Personnel (teachers) – 12% ▪ Educational Support Employees – 9% ▪ Administrators – 5% ▪ Keep in mind 2% of the base pay raise for all employees was due to the voter approved M&O Override passed last November. ○ The BA entry level teacher pay at PVUSD is \$39,240 ○ PVUSD has about 2,000 teachers. For 2018-19 we have 175 new teachers. With approximately 50 of these teachers being “new” to teaching. ○ We had fewer transportation issues as district was able to hire many drivers over summer. ○ Teacher openings across the district are much less than last year. Breakdown is: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Elementary – 10 ▪ Middle School – 2 ▪ High School 1 ▪ There are no teacher openings in Math/Science....yeah, yeah.....!!! ○ For Horizon we do not have any teacher openings but we do have a couple of coaching and support employee positions open. ○ Overall the district has experienced an enrollment loss of about 350 students. This is mainly at the elementary level due to expansion and opening of several of Charter schools in the area. As an example Copper Canyon lost approximately 100 students (mostly to Basis). ○ Next UPC meeting is Sept 26 at our District Office.
